Laws of indoor

- 1. The field of play will be a 30'x60' turf field. The ball can play off of the perimeter walls, but if the ball makes contact with the safety net the ball is dead and the opposing team takes possession.
- 2. The ball will be a size 4 futsal ball for each age group. TSA will provide the ball for all games.
- 3. U8, U10, and U12 games will be played with no more than 4 players for each team on the field, including the goalie. You may play with a minimum of 3 players at all times.
- 4. The rosters will be no larger than 6 players for U8, U10, and U12. The rosters will be no larger than 5 players for U14.
- 5. Equipment required to participate for each player is shin guards, and closed toe athletic shoes. Cleats or indoor shoes are encouraged, but not a requirement.
- 6. The referees are to be respected by all players, coaches, and fans. Yellow and red cards will be in play and enforced during the indoor season.
 - Offsides will not be enforced.
 - Player control fouls will be enforced, and will result in a direct kick for the opposing team.
 - Hand ball rules will be enforced, and the opposing team will receive a direct kick from the spot of the foul.
 - For all free place kicks 3 steps will be given to the kicking team for space.

- 1. Each match will be 40 minutes in total. There will be two 20 minute halves with a brief 2 minute intermission. Games will be during a 45 minute window, so there will be no grace period for late arrivals. The clock will start at exactly the right time each game.
- 2. All start and stoppages of play will be decided by the referee. The referee will have the final say on all calls.
- 3. The ball is considered in play the entire time that it is inside the walls of the pitch. If the ball contacts the net in any way the last team to touch the ball will lose possession.
- 4. The score will be kept by the referee, and it will be reported at the end of each game by the referee.
- 5. Scoring will be kept in the same way as outdoor soccer. Each goal is worth one point in the match. At the end of regulation the score of the game will be concluded. No extra time will be awarded, all wins, losses, and draws will be final.
- 6. Fouls and misconduct will be at the referee's discretion. Fouls and misconduct will be handled in the same manner as outdoor games.
- 7. Penalty kicks will be awarded by the referee if there is a foul during the act of scoring, or if there is a foul when there is a direct line to the goal for the opposing player. Penalty kicks will be stepped off by the referee to be 7 steps from the goal. All other players must be 10 steps from the goal. The opposing team's goalie will be permitted to stay in goal. They must stay on the goal line until the ball has been contacted by the player taking the shot. The penalty kick will begin on the referee's whistle
- 8. All out of play balls will be put back into play with a kick in. There will be no throw-ins.
- 9. Goal kicks will be placed on the edge of three steps from the goal line.
- 10. Corner kicks will be placed on a designated spot on the field.
